B.Grimm has evolved into a multinational conglomerate spanning energy, industrial systems, healthcare, transportation, lifestyle, and real estate. B.Grimm believes that true prosperity is not just measured by financial success but by fostering happiness, balance, and longevity in the communities B.Grimm serves.

In the 1990s, B.Grimm entered the energy sector with its first greenfield industrial power plant in Amata City, Chonburi. Today, B.Grimm Power is a key player in Thailand's energy landscape, with 56 operational projects and an ambitious goal of achieving 7,200 MW of secured power purchase agreements by 2025, further expanding to 10,000 MW by 2030. B.Grimm Power is actively driving the transition towards net zero carbon emissions by 2050.
