

Frequently Asked Questions on the Housing Journey Youth Panel

1. What is the SG Youth Plan?

The [SG Youth Plan](#) reflects the voices, aspirations, and concerns of our youths, and sets out a whole-of-society roadmap to journey with and empower youths to become the best versions of themselves. The SG Youth Plan includes initiatives to support our youths to become **confident** youths who are **connected** to their communities, and who **contribute** meaningfully towards building our shared future.

2. Who can apply for the Housing Journey Youth Panel?

The Housing Journey Youth Panel is open to youths who:

- Are Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents
- Are aged 18 to 35 years old
- Have an interest in housing issues and desire to improve the home ownership journey for Singaporeans
- Intend to buy an HDB flat for themselves in the future

We welcome applicants from diverse backgrounds, including students, young working adults, and those active in community or youth networks.

3. Do I need prior knowledge or experience in housing to participate?

Basic knowledge of the public housing landscape in Singapore and the HDB flat-buying journey is appreciated, but not necessary. The programme will offer opportunities to learn more about HDB's housing policies and the flat buying journey. We are also looking to understand your perspectives and views and co-create ideas to help youths looking to embark on their homeownership journey.

4. How will participants be selected?

Applicants must submit a brief written and video response as part of the application process. We are looking for participants who are keen to share their views, open to exploring issues from different angles, and comfortable engaging with different points of view.

5. What is the expected commitment? Can I sit out of certain segments?

The programme will run for approximately nine (9) months from January to September 2027, with activities organised across several phases. Participants are strongly encouraged to commit to the engagement sessions to the best of their ability, as each segment builds on the previous

one and consistent participation is important for a meaningful experience. Occasional scheduling conflicts may be excused with early indication.

Please note that those with low participation may not be eligible to receive the certificate of participation.

6. Are there any costs to participate?

There are no fees involved for joining the programme.

7. When and how will I know if I have been selected?

Shortlisted applicants will be notified about three (3) weeks after registration closes. Applicants are encouraged to keep a lookout for updates via their registered contact details.
