The Gold Standard is a certification program for climate and development projects, designed to ensure that these projects have measurable, verifiable, and sustainable impacts on both the environment and local communities. The Gold Standard was established in 2003 by a group of NGOs, including WWF and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), with the aim of promoting high-quality, credible carbon offset projects that go beyond just reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.
